



TCC Radio | Listener's Script for Loved Ones June 2010

The following Gospel conversation script is very similar to that used by our TCC Radio reps throughout the production of our special series called "Here Comes the Bride", discussing the mission and ministry of the true Church of Christ. It has been slightly edited to be used with personal loved ones.

Hi, <name>, I've been listening to a great radio show lately. They do spiritual surveys with people on the street and broadcast the interviews on the air. Right now they're asking people about church. Can I survey you about it?

Just in time for summer, the radio series is titled "Here Comes the Bride"...

1. *Do you consider yourself to be a "spiritual" person?*
2. *Have you ever attended church before?*
3. *What is a church to you? What is "The Church" to you?*
4. *Has anyone ever invited you to "Church"? Why did they invite you?*
5. *Did you actually end up going? If so...*
 - *What happened while you were there? For example, what was the focus of the event or meeting you attended?*
 - *If you went, did it actually impact your life? How?*
 - *Have you continued going or would you go again?*
6. *If I were to invite you to church, would you go? What about if a close friend invited you? Why or why not?*
7. *CHRISTIAN Church is obviously about Jesus Christ. Do you know who He is, what He did and why?*

BRIDGE: *Do you have any idea how going to church relates to going to heaven? (Do you think you're going?)*

(Share Gospel & end with "The Church" is all God's people, who go to heaven not because of what THEY'VE done, but because of what HE'S done).

The question is, where will you spend eternity? The Bible says that the price of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus.

So, how many times have you sinned? How many times have you lied, lusted, stolen, hated, used God's Name in vain? Because every time you have, you've sinned against Holy God, alienating yourself from Him – even your thinking has been against Him. Unless something is done, you will face the second death, which is eternity in the Lake of Fire!

But Jesus Christ paid for your sins, taking them and God's wrath against you, upon Himself. He shed His blood and died on the Cross in your place, and then He rose from the grave, defeating sin and death – just as the Scriptures foretold that He would!

To be reconciled to God, you must repent (wake up!) to trust that Jesus died for your sins. Your sins will be forgiven and God will grant you eternal life. Then you can expect God to start truly changing you from the inside out, filling you with His abundant new life and purpose! His new life and purpose in you will ultimately result in you being together with Him in Heaven. Isn't that Good News?
